What is TEC? TEC (Teens Encounter Christ) is a three-day weekend that makes available to young people the possibility of experiencing a loving and supportive faith community. Team members are made up of adults and teens. They share some of the struggles, joys, and feelings they have experienced in their lives. On TEC weekends, young people experience Christian community. TEC is a program developed by the Catholic Church and includes services such as the Mass. Applicants of other faiths are welcome and are under no pressure to participate in any services that would violate their own beliefs. Our TEC weekends are held at the new Believers Together Community Center at Christ the King Catholic Church in Moline.

Parent's Meeting: A parent's informational meeting is held each TEC weekend at 9:00 on Saturday morning in the Cafeteria immediately after you've been dropped off for your TEC weekend. Any questions they might have can be answered at this time.

You will be notified of acceptance at least 2 weeks prior to your TEC. **IMPORTANT...**Please inform the TEC office immediately if you are not able to attend this weekend, as there could be a waiting list. The fee for the weekend is \$50. This will cover the weekend expenses.
