

## SECTION 6: FORMATION MEETINGS – MEETING 3

John 12:24 *"Unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains a single grain of wheat but if it dies it will bear much fruit."*

**Important for ALL meetings: Place Leader Reflection and Sharing in Middle of Meeting**  
for best attendance and participation

### **Third WT Meeting**

- **This meeting “may” include Reconciliation**
- **PT/PTASD may extend the invitation to participate in their Emmaus Walk practice**

**Before meeting:** Touch base with PT for meeting needs; touch base throughout meeting

5 min. WSL – Lead Opening Prayer

10 min Leader(s)

- Forms must be submitted **today**
- Collect money for weekend/pizza

WSL

- Discuss PT previews
  - Learn from your PT Prayer Partner what you can specifically pray for
- Discuss Pray Ups/Downs – singing/humming
  - Songs are selected based on the day
    - Die – more solemn
    - Rise – energetic, joyful
    - Go Forth – motivating
  - See song suggestions on page 46
- Practice a Pray Up

15 min WSL(s)

- Plan a thought-provoking video or discussion to prepare for Reconciliation - either at BTC or elsewhere
- Set up Reconciliation (if applicable) based on number of priests, location, etc. (candles, Kleenex, water bottles, confession guides?)

30-45 min. Reconciliation (if not occurring – use time for projects)

- WT usually goes first so they can get through and get back to work

60 mins Leader facilitates **Prayer** reflection; WSL or Leader facilitates prayer service / sharing

## SECTION 6: FORMATION MEETINGS – MEETING 3

- 10-20 mins Meet with PT Prayer Partner; give them Wheat letter  
**Note:** This may be in the form of the PT's Emmaus Walk practice.
- 40 min Work on smaller projects such as:
- Wheat Bags
  - Wheat Chain – everyone contributes
  - Folders for weekend
  - Preparing TEC crosses
  - Wrapping Bibles
- 10 mins Leader(s): Closing Comments
- Do Wheat!
    - Write your Wheat down so you can add this to the Wheat Chain
  - Recruit Candidates – applications available online
  - Begin your Candidate letters
  - Confirm location of next meeting, if different
  - Have Wheat Letters ready for **both** Prayer Partners and bring to next meeting. Have them DONE...This will not be done during our meeting.
  - If not paid, bring money for weekend
    - Reminder: If unable to pay full or partial, see one of the Leaders.
  - Make sure everyone has required forms:
    - Safe Environment / Safe Driving
      - Safe Driving required for anyone 16 and older by weekend
    - CANTS form – if minor must be signed by parent
    - permission slips if **under 18 – due by next meeting or may not be able to serve**
  - Assign snacks for next meeting
  - Expectations for next meeting / Questions?
- 5 mins WSL – Lead Closing Prayer; encourage spontaneous prayer

### **Post Leader's Meeting:**

- Discuss next meeting schedule
- Note and discuss Wheaties (potential leaders, those with struggles, conflicts, key issues from sharing, etc.)
- Follow-up with PT SD / ASD to determine needs for next meeting (para-liturgy set-ups, reconciliation, etc.)
