- **Check status of everything – what is yet to be done?**
- Practice dance
- Die Day letters (this can be done Saturday morning too)
 - Write extra Die Day letters for weekend
 - Have 6 people write weekend Wheat letters (this can be done on the weekend too):
 - Die Day- 2 letters
 - Rise Day – 2 letters
 - Go Forth Day – 2 letters
- Organize Die Day letter box (if have candidate names)
- Write up Chapel coverage
- Snacks during this work time

WSL(s)

- Meet with PTASD re: Saturday morning prayer service

60 mins Leader facilitates **Discipleship** reflection; WSL or Leader facilitates prayer service / sharing

45 mins WSL / Leaders

- Practice Passion 1 or 2x
- Practice Resurrection Prayer Service **with PT**

15 mins Leader(s)

- Pass out copy of weekend reminders
- Facilitate review of reminders

Leader(s): Final review

1. Pray!!!
2. Display leadership and guide others as needed – Pray!
 - PT team family/friends here for Pray Up/Pray Down
 - Candidate family/friends here to help serve meals, etc.
 - **At the Hoot**, look for parents of Candidates and guide them to the front of the line when heading to the church
3. During the weekend, keep the building clean. This is part of your Wheat.
4. Regularly check bathrooms (when Candidates are known to be in the Chapel, at a meal, etc.), empty full trash, pick up items left on the floor, etc. — Pray!
5. Not a party weekend - service to others / dying to self is our mission – Pray!
6. Do what is requested, when requested — Pray!
7. Keep the Wheat room neat and clean at all times — this is a reflection of you as a team — must be cleaned each night before we go to bed — Pray!
8. Put all supplies back into the **correct** containers – think about the next team’s needs; containers are clearly marked — Pray!
9. There will be no phone calls made on the TEC weekend except as needed. You might just leave your phones at home. — Pray!
10. Review Friday evening:
 - Foot washing
 - Presentation of Banner, Leader Candle, and Wheat Team
 - Have your final Wheat letter for your PT prayer partner
11. We are expected to consistently display appropriate Christian behavior; if you become overwhelmed or upset, take a breath, excuse yourself, and speak with one of the Leaders/WSL(s); sometimes it happens.
12. Review the job listing often (whiteboard or poster).
13. This weekend we are asked to live out the Paschal Mystery – dying to ourselves, giving to others so they can encounter Christ.
14. Get your rest this week! You can’t give what you don’t have and you’re going to need energy.
15. **Recruit Candidates – it’s not too late** - applications available online.
16. Set up starts @ **4 PM on Friday**. Be here as soon as you can.
 - Parking – Friday up close is fine. Cars must be moved early Sat a.m. to far NE corner
